Based on real cases, and set in Greece, Cyprus, London, and occasionally Albania, Say You Never Met Me opens a window into the violent and sordid world of human trafficking.

Until a few months ago, George, was a director of a London bank, but having done something reprehensible, dishonourable and possibly criminal, he has deserted his wife, and fled with his girlfriend, Susanna, to a remote Greek island.

While travelling back to England, Susanna is caught up in a people smuggling operation. George reluctantly travels to join her, but before they can be reunited, George is mugged and Susanna is killed in a hit and run accident. George, travelling under a false name and with his paranoia in full spate, is arrested.

Once free, he resolves to track down the traffickers and help the women and girls who are being sold onto London's sex scene.

Throughout, George escapes into reminiscences about his childhood, schooldays, family holidays and scouting activities that were, for him, happier times. Readers who are fans of nineties and early 'noughties' rock music, and anyone who grew up in the sixties will experience a warm glow of recognition.
